- Copy of both sides of your 2023-2024 Student Aid Report as a result of your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) which indicates the Student Aid Index (SIA) [previously known as Expected Family Contribution or EFC.]
- Copy of most recent academic transcript.
- Letter of recommendation from one of the following: College Instructor, College Counselor, or Board Member of your Rainbow or DeMolay Chapter.
- **Personal statement** of up to 250 words (equivalent of one typed page) of your academic goals and how the Grant will help you accomplish them.
