The cap may be worn as part of the Templar Uniform, except during the Order of the Temple, which will require a chapeau.

### **Reason:**

At the Annual Communication some expressed that a chapeau should be required during the conferral of the Order of the Temple. This additional sentence would satisfy this concern.
