- Copy of most recent academic transcript.
- First-time applicants **MUST** provide at least one letter of recommendation from one of the following: College Instructor, College Counselor, or Board Member of your Rainbow or DeMolay Chapter. Previous Educational Grant recipients are not required to submit a letter of recommendation but may do so if they wish.
- Personal statement of up to 250 words (equivalent of one typed page) of your academic goals and how the Grant will help you accomplish them.
